After School Fees Full Time: 3-5 days/week - **\$185**/month Part Time: 1-2 days/week - **\$130**/month Program Hours 3:00pm - 6:00pm

Late Fee: Any account not paid in full by the 30th of the month will incur a \$15 late fee.

Monthly fees are averaged for the Ten month school year. Therefore no matter how many school attendance days are in a month, the monthly fee remains the same. The YWCA of the Niagara Frontier staff prepares plans that include a wide range of supervised activities:

- Daily Snack (afternoon)
- Indoor and outdoor sports and games
- Arts and crafts
- STEM enrichment
- Quiet time for homework and reading
- Homework assistance

All activities are designated to promote positive self-esteem, appreciation and respect for each child's background and culture.

Early Release

A program for "early release school days" is held at the school your child attends. **If your child normally attends the After School Program on that given day, there is no additional fee.** If your child does not normally attend the After School Program on this day, the additional fee is \$15.00 per day. Advanced registration is required for this program.
