**The YWCA of the Niagara Frontier will be providing YWCA Munk/Human Scholarships for women returning to secondary education effective for the Fall Semester 2019.**

To be eligible, potential recipients must meet the following criteria:

- 1) Committee will make a selection on non-traditional female student pursuing a higher education with ties to Niagara County. The committee will use the National Center for Educational Statistics' definition of a non-traditional students (including, but not limited to, full-time or part-time students).
- 2) Students pursuing any higher-education following high school or achievement of a GED will be considered for award. This includes, but is not limited to, students pursuing an undergraduate, graduate or associated degree as well as accreditation and certification programs.
- 3) Students residing in Niagara County or who have used the services of the YWCA of Niagara Frontier will be given preference.
