The YWCA's SACC (School Age Child Care) Program is registered by the NYS Office of Child and Family Services. The following information must be submitted before your child is considered registered in this program:

- Completed Enrollment
- Medical Health history
- OCFS Health Screening form
- Front desk auto pay info
- Copy of child's physical and immunization records
- First month paid at time of registration

Before School Fees

Full Time:

3-5 days/week - \$160/month

Part Time:

1-2 days/week - \$100/month

Program hours

7:00am – 8:40am

After School Fees

Full Time:

3-5 days/week - \$175/month

Part Time:

1-2 days/week - \$120/month

Program Hours

3:00pm – 6:00pm

**There is a 10% discount for second child

THE 25th of the month before**

Late Fee: Any account not paid in full by the 30th of the month will incur a \$15 late fee.

Monthly fees are averaged for the Ten month school year. Therefore no matter how many school attendance days are in a month, the monthly fee remains the same.

The YWCA of the Niagara Frontier staff prepares plans that include a wide range of supervised activities:

- ◆ Daily Snack (afternoon)
- ◆ Indoor and outdoor sports and games
- ◆ Arts and crafts
- ◆ STEM enrichment
- ◆ Quiet time for homework and reading
- ◆ Homework assistance

All activities are designated to promote positive self-esteem, appreciation and respect for each child's background and culture.

Early Release

A program for "early release school days" is held at the school your child attends. **If your child normally attends the After School Program on that given day, there is no additional fee.** If your child does not normally attend the After School Program on this day, the additional fee is \$15.00 per day. Advanced registration is required for this program.
