

Enrollment:

Children must have completed Kindergarten. You may register your child for any number of weeks. Schedule changes may be made without penalty until Friday, June 10. After June 10, you will be financially responsible for all registered weeks.

Program Hours: 7:00am– 5:30pm

The cost of the program

Full Time 3-5 days is \$180.00 per week

Part Time: 2 days is \$80.00 per week.

One week advance payment is due at time of registration, which is applied to the final week of enrollment.

ALL payments are withdrawn from your account on the Monday of the week prior to attending.

Week 1 payment will be due by June 20st.
